- 1. We support measures to ensure what might be called 'safety and privacy by design.'
- 2. We firmly believe that online services should recognise the potential for harm and design in protections.
- 3. The existing regulations, legislation etc may or may not be strong enough in the increasingly digital world (that is for debate) but those safety measures should certainly not be weakened by the new Code.
- 4. The Code should clarify what is meant in the GDPR by the phrase "children merit specific protection."
